As part of the instant criminal case, the defendant makes the following representations to the Court and law enforcement under penalty of perjury:


1. The defendant has disclosed all assets owned by him and/or held by a third party for the defendant's benefit whether any such assets are within or outside the United States.
2. The defendant has identified and disclosed the whereabouts of any proceeds of the fraud that are known to him whether any such proceeds are within or outside the United States.
3. The defendant understands and acknowledges that identification and recovery of the defendant's assets and proceeds of the fraud are relevant to law enforcement as part of an ongoing criminal investigation and relate to the violation of a criminal statute.
4. The defendant understands and acknowledges that the

foregoing representations are material to law enforcement and its ongoing criminal investigation and within the jurisdiction of law enforcement.

5. The defendant understands and acknowledges that he will be subject to further criminal prosecution if his representations are false.

6. For purposes of any criminal prosecution regarding the statements made herein, the defendant knowingly, voluntarily and irrevocably waives the statute-of-limitations period and will be estopped from raising the statute of limitations as a defense if he is prosecuted for the representations made herein.
