**PLAINTIFF’S RESPONSE TO MOTION TO APPROVE THE
PAYMENT OF FEES INCURRED BY THE RECEIVER**

On October 20, 2010, Receiver R.J. Zayed filed a Motion with this Court seeking approval of fees and costs he incurred in or about September 2010 in performing his duties as Receiver (CFTC Dkt. # 502). The Motion also seeks approval of fees and costs incurred by separate counsel retained by the Receiver to assist with the recovery of Receivership assets located in the Republic of Panama, a domestic law firm retained to assist with certain bankruptcy issues, and a firm that provided investigatory services in connection with the Receiver’s attempt to recover Receivership assets. Because it

appears that the fees and costs the Receiver seeks are appropriate and substantiated by the declaration filed in support of the Receiver's Motion (CFTC Dkt. # 504), the Commodity Futures Trading Commission does not oppose the Motion.
