

AFFIDAVIT OF PIPER KENNEY WEBB

3. Cook has answered all questions asked of him. He has not asserted his Fifth Amendment privilege to any of these questions and his attorneys have not directed him to refuse to answer any questions posed.
4. On September 29, 2010, Mr. Cook testified before this Court regarding his inability to comply with the Court's contempt order. At the close of Mr. Cook's testimony, his counsel agreed to continue the hearing to allow the SEC and Receiver another opportunity to interview Mr. Cook for two additional days on October 5-6, 2010. The Receiver and SEC interviewed Cook over these two days for approximately 11 hours. After those two days of interviews, the SEC and Receiver requested that Cook agree to another set of interviews on October 27-28, 2010. Our office agreed to a continuance of the purge hearing to November 1, 2010.
5. The SEC and Receiver interviewed Cook on October 27-28 for approximately 9 hours. During the interview on October 27th, Mr. Cook signed numerous withdrawal request forms for funds sent to foreign gambling accounts in an effort to have the money returned.
6. On October 19-21, Mr. Cook also met with a Magistrate Judge from Switzerland for 3 days of interviews. The purpose of these interviews was to assist the Swiss Government in its investigation of Crown Forex S.A. With the assistance of a French translator, Mr. Cook answered all questions posed to him about Crown Forex S.A. as well as other Swiss entities. At the October 28th interview with the SEC and Receiver, counsel for Cook described the interviews with the Swiss Magistrate.

7. Since Cook testified before this Court on September 29, he has spent approximately 35 hours over 7 days answering questions posed to him by the United States and Swiss Government.
